HISTORY:

Bowls have been played, in one form or another, for centuries of years, combining strategy, competition, sociability, affordability and most of all FUN!

THE GAME:

The game is played on a wide smooth grass surface (*golf green*), called a Green. By the way, Pointe-Claire's Green is amongst the finest in Eastern Canada!

THE EQUIPMENT:

The equipment used is your Bowls, which are bowling size, made of hard resin with a deviation (*called Bias*) so that they follow an elliptical path rather than rolling in a straight line, another small, smooth white bowl called the "Jack," and a mat from which you play.

OBJECT OF BOWLS:

The object of Bowls, as in Bocce or Curling, is to get your Bowls closer to the Jack than the Bowls of your opponent. This is achieved by players from each team taking turns rolling their Bowls down the Green toward the Jack.
